



PPE (PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT) GUIDELINES FOR QMRS TEAM MEMBERS

These guidelines provide advice about using personal protective equipment (PPE) to minimise exposure to risks associated with being an active team member in the Queensland Mines Rescue Service Ltd (QMRS).

As per Standard Operating Procedures used on your minesite, the current requirements for QMRS operations are the same, and should be followed to the letter. Failure to wear PPE while responding to incidents, training or competing will result in the team member being excused. Safety signs are positioned around the station for your protection, so please observe the signs.

Under no circumstances are open shoes (i.e. thongs) to be worn in or around the station, even after utilising the bathhouse showers.



The following table lists PPE requirements for the QMRS.
